Spiritual / Biblical Benefits

At least 88% of the graduates agree that the courses in their program/major helped them develop spiritually and biblically in the following areas:

- *development of their Christian Worldview (88%),
- *development of their Bible knowledge (100%),
- *increased their committed to the cause of Christ (88%),
- *increased their spiritual maturity (94%), and
- *helped them develop a framework for making decisions about morality (100%),
- *helped them synthesize components academic knowledge and Christian values (94%),

Educational Benefits

- *82% agree they are satisfied with the quality of instruction in their major.
- *At least 82% agree that the courses in their major helped develop their writing skills (94%), reading skills (88%), speaking skills (88%), as well as their analytical reasoning skills (82%).
- *82% developed special techniques for acquiring knowledge in their field of study.
- *82% agreed that the courses in their major well-prepared them for a career in their field of study.

Social Benefits

- *88% agreed they gained increased awareness of their social responsibility as well as increased sensitivity to the needs of others.
- *82% agreed that the courses in their major contributed to their knowledge and understanding of other cultures.
